- ✓ **Diagnostic testing** is beneficial for assessing depression, anxiety, ADHD, autistic spectrum disorders, developmental disorders, etc.
- ✓ **Tests of academic and cognitive functioning** are administered to assess intelligence, language problems, visual motor skills, memory, attention, organizational skills, career interest, learning disorders, etc.
- ✓ **Psychological tests** assess for symptoms of mood disorders and personality disorders.
- ✓ **Cognitive decline** due to aging in older adults is determined by assessing the cognitive baseline, level of decline, and determining if there are memory impairments.
- ✓ **Social Security Disability Assessments** are available.

The Initial Consultation:

During the initial visit with the psychologist, the client's questions and concerns are explored. After a thorough history is taken, a recommendation is made about the most appropriate assessment option. Then the testing process is explained and the testing sessions are scheduled.

At this visit, you may also have questions about who will see the results and how they may affect you or your child. These and any other questions about the assessment will be answered during the initial visit. Our staff of caring professionals provides an environment for testing that is comfortable for both adults and children.

A Comprehensive Psychological Assessment Includes:

1. **The initial visit** with the psychologist seeks to discuss questions, obtain history, schedule the testing, and familiarize you and/or your child with the testing process.
2. **The testing session** includes administration of all recommended tests. The amount of time involved will vary depending on the age of the person being tested, the nature of the concerns, and the extent of testing required. If necessary, testing may be administered over several testing sessions.
3. **A follow-up session** is scheduled once the comprehensive report has been generated. At that time, test results and recommendations will be fully explained.
4. **Phone consultations** with school faculty or the referring provider may be offered, if appropriate.
